

F006 LVV Certification Plate Pre-order Form Introduction

Background

For some time, LVVTA has been trying to enable a more stream-lined LVV certification process to occur for those LVV certifications carried out that are of a repetitive nature, for commercial modifiers. The objective is to reduce the time delay between the final sign-off of the vehicle by the LVV Certifier, and the LVV certification plate being fitted to the vehicle. With courier time two ways, and plate production time, this can vary from 3-5 days, which often causes inconvenience and additional cost to the commercial modification company.

Development of the LVV certification plate pre-ordering system

During 2008, the LVV Operating Requirements Schedule (ORS) was amended to allow for LVV certification plate pre-ordering under certain conditions, so that the plate could be fitted to the vehicle at the time of final inspection. The conditions and details of the process are set out in 4.2 of the LVV ORS. Paragraph 4.2(1)(b)(vi) of the ORS requires that a LVVTA F006 Certification Plate Pre-order Request Form be supplied when requesting a plate under the pre-ordering system.

Introduction of the F006 Pre-order Form

This form has been developed, and is now available for use for those LVV Certifiers authorised for the LV-PO category, as detailed in 3.1(15) and 3.2(15) of the LVV ORS.

Gaining authorisation for LV-PO

LVV Certifiers wishing to become authorised should read 3.1(15), 3.2(15), and 4.2 of the LVV ORS, and if satisfied that all criteria are met, apply for authorisation to NZTA.
